If the answer is \"that's because searches about 2 or 3 letters words are not relevant\" I would then object that Google is dealing with it good it seems by himself, I believe, and if not, I would suggest to make a filter on language basis in which we could add every non relevant little words. That's what good Seo do (like vBseo)and it would be very helpfull in your module ;-) You will tell me \"that's a lot of work\", and in this case I have nothing more to say ;-)

I'm also wondering if the api keycode adds really someting. It seems to work without...
